

MDA SCHOLARSHIP, 2018

RULES OF THE MDA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

1. The MDA Scholarship is offered by Musicians' Dream Aid (MDA). One scholarship of \$700 (CAD) and one scholarship of \$300 (CAD) will be offered.
2. Adjudicator: TBD
3. The scholarship must be used towards the tuition of a music school or program, and not towards any other expenses (such as living expenses, travel expenses, etc).
4. All young musicians who have Canadian citizenship or are living in Canada and are under the age of 20 on June 11th, 2018 are eligible. The winner of the 2017 MDA Scholarship is not eligible.
5. Applicants will be judged based on their technical and musical proficiency, musical background, and how they intend to use the scholarship should they receive it.
6. The scholarship will be sent directly to the school/program of the applicant's choice.
7. The winner and runner-up will be required to submit a written testimonial on how the scholarship has helped their musical education which MDA may use for promotional purposes. Details will be provided when receiving the scholarship.
8. The candidates must submit the required application by June 11th, 2018.
9. The scholarship application should include:
 - a. A completed application form (obtain from website)
 - b. Unedited video file(s) or YouTube video(s) of the applicant playing two contrasting works
 - c. A biography of the applicant (maximum 300 words)
 - d. A photo of the applicant
 - e. Proof of residency or citizenship
10. The video(s) must clearly show that the applicant is playing.
11. The biographies and photos submitted by applicants may be used by the organization for promotional purposes.
